

Broken Slate Replacement – Readyslate

<u>Step 1</u>: Cut the top of the exposed area of the broken slate with an angle grinder or a circular saw (with an appropriate stone disc). Insert a metal sheet underneath in order to protect the underlayment




<u>Step 2</u>: Rise the broken piece by placing 2 wooden wedges in both sides (in the adjacent slates). Then cut the membrane by the gap of both sides with a cutter



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<u>Step 3</u>: Spread the wooden wedges out to make room for the replace piece



Step 4: Snap the piece into place <u>without removing the protective film</u> (otherwise you won't be able) and once the membrane is below the edge of the upper row, remove the film.



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


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Step 5: Remove the protective film and fit the replacement piece. Withdraw the wedges and press the edges



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
